



The ships and their interior design

Hurtigruten/The Norwegian Coastal Voyage is served by a new and modern fleet of 11 ships. The facilities provided by the ships are uniform, but the choice of colours, materials and design means that each ship retains its own character. They have large, comfortable lounges providing good views, extremely good facilities for meetings and conferences, wonderful cabins and suites of a high standard, fully licensed restaurants, cafés and bars, and souvenir shops that also sell a selection of toiletries. The majority of the ships also have fitness rooms and saunas for passengers. MS Finnmarken also has an outdoor pool and a spa. The very newest ships have several bars, restaurants and cafés with varied menus, extended conference facilities and internet cafés. All the ships, with the exception of MS Lofoten, have good facilities for disabled people and have lifts. MS Lofoten, which is a traditional ship, is used as a replacement ship during the winter season.



Art on board

All our ships place great emphasis on artistic decoration. They contain a multitude of oil paintings, water-colours, prints and sculptures that have resulted in the ships being called floating art galleries. Many of the artists come from places along the route of the world's most beautiful voyage, and even more have allowed themselves to be inspired by the fantastic Norwegian coastal scenery. On board some of the ships you will find works of art taken from older ships that plied the route, and the majority have works by well-known modern artists such as Eva, Jan and Karl Erik Harr, Inger Sitter, Ørnulf Opdahl, Dagfinn Bakke, Frans and Nico Widerberg, Per Kleiva, Kenneth Blom, Trym Ivar Bergsmo, Kjell Nupen, Kåre Tveter, Håkon Bleken and Magne Furuholmen.
